- 2 3/4 cup all purpose flour
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 1 tbsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 3/4 cup butter softened
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup whole milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 6 strawberries sliced
- Blueberries



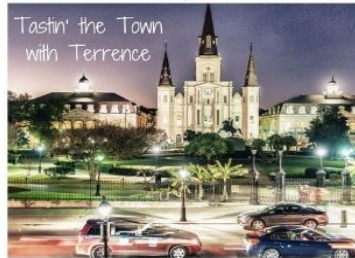
Berry Chantilly Cupcakes

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, stir together flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. Add butter, eggs, milk and vanilla extract and beat until mixed well. Transfer batter into lined muffin cups, leaving 1/2" of space to the top. Bake in preheated oven for 16 - 20 minutes, until an inserted toothpick comes out clean. Allow to cool, and top with mascarpone cream frosting, and top with sliced strawberries and blueberries.

Mascarpone Cream Frosting

8 oz mascarpone cheese; 2 cups heavy whipping cream; 1/4 cup sugar; 1 tsp vanilla extract
In a large bowl, add mascarpone cheese, heavy whipping cream, sugar and vanilla extract, and beat until frosting thickens up and stiff peaks form.

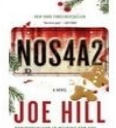
