- 1 pound 1/2-inch-cubed skinless red snapper fillet (from 1 [2-pound] skin-on red snapper fillet)
- 1 cup lime juice (from 8 large limes)
- 3/4 cup 3/4-inch-diced plum tomato
- 1 small red onion finely chopped
- 1 ripe avocado, diced
- 1/4 cup fresh orange juice
- 1 teaspoon finely chopped serrano chile or 2 teaspoons finely chopped jalapeño
- 1 teaspoon sea salt, plus more to taste
- 1/3 cup loosely packed fresh cilantro leaves, chopped
- 2 tablespoons salted roasted pepitas (pumpkin seeds)



Classic Ceviche'

Place fish in a medium-size nonreactive bowl. Add lime juice; gently fold to combine, making sure fish is covered with juice. Cover and chill until fish is opaque and firm, about 30 minutes. Drain and discard liquid. Gently fold in tomato, radishes, orange juice, chile, and salt. Top with cilantro and pepitas, and, if desired, sprinkle with salt to taste. Serve immediately with desired chips.

My Wine Recommendation:

Porta Sauvignon Blanc Reserva - touch of acidity, a very good aromatic intensity with layers of tropical fruit and melon that mix with citric and floral notes in its finish. (\$19.99 - Total Wine)
